Amending Regulation (EU) 2024/1157 of the European Parliament and of the Council as regards wastes and mixtures of wastes listed in Annex III, Annex IIIA, Annex IIIB, and Annex IV

ANNEX

Annexes III, IIIA, IIIB and IV to Regulation (EU) 2024/1157 are amended as follows:

(1) In Annex III, Part II, the entries GC010 and GC020 are deleted;

(2) In Annex IIIA, Part 1, point 4, the following point (d) is added:

‘(d) mixtures of wastes classified under entry B3030 and footwear, hats, belts or other accessories.’;

(4) In Annex IIIB, point 2 the following is added:

‘BEU06 Non-hazardous waste composed of fibre-reinforced polymer composites, such as glass fibre embedded in polymer resins, which may also include coatings, adhesives and core materials, provided that it is destined for recycling.

BEU07 Waste consisting mainly of aluminium, steel, or both, derived from building, construction and demolition activities, including door frames, window frames, curtain walls and other framing profiles, and which may contain minimal amounts of coating, plastic, rubber and other materials or other metal components provided that the aluminium or steel remains the dominant recoverable fraction.

BEU08 Waste mattresses, dry-collected and provided they are destined for recycling.

BEU09 Electrical and electronic waste:

- Waste electrical and electronic equipment that has undergone proper treatment in accordance with Article 8(2) of Directive 2012/19/EU and in which none of the components display any of the hazardous properties listed in Annex III to Directive 2008/98/EC;.
- Waste components of electrical and electronic equipment, such as printed circuit boards, that do not display any of the hazardous properties listed in Annex III to Directive 2008/98/EC, and where such components are not covered by another entry in Annex III, IIIA or IIIB to this Regulation;
- Wastes arising from the processing of waste electrical and electronic equipment or waste components of electrical and electronic equipment, such as fractions arising from shredding or dismantling, that do not display any of the hazardous properties listed in Annex III of Directive 2008/98/EC, and where such waste is not covered by another entry in Annex III, IIIA or IIIB to this Regulation.

BEU10 Solid, inert permanent magnets from waste electrical and electronic equipment, from end-of-life wind turbine and related infrastructure or from end-of-life vehicles.

BEU11 Metal waste from end-of-life vehicles that were treated in accordance with Articles 28 and 29 of Regulation (EU) 2026/1738 of the European Parliament and of the Council¹ on

circularity requirements for vehicle design and on management of end-of-life vehicles, which may contain minimal amounts of other materials, such as plastic, rubber and other materials, provided that metal remains the dominant recoverable fraction.'

(5) In Annex IV, Part I, point (g) is replaced by the following:

'(g) For waste shipped within the Union, Basel entry Y49 shall not apply and the following entry shall apply instead:

EU49 Waste electrical and electronic equipment, not covered by A1181 or BEU09.'
